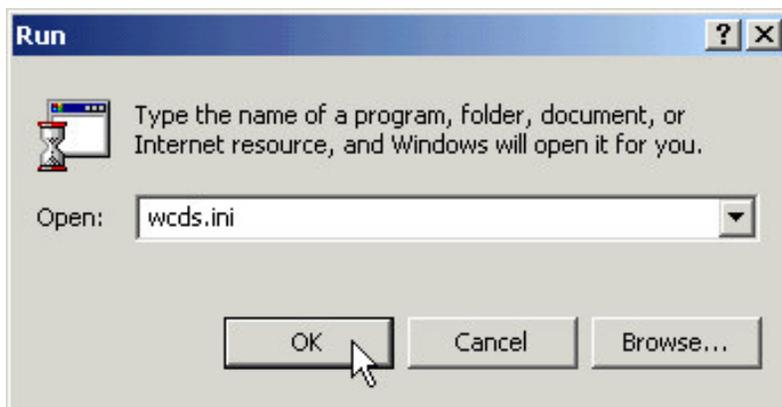
## Volume 27: Launching CDS in Calendar View

To set the Client Data System (CDS) to launch in calendar view:

- Click **Start** on the Windows taskbar and select **Run**



- In the **Open** field of the **Run** window, type `wcds.ini`.



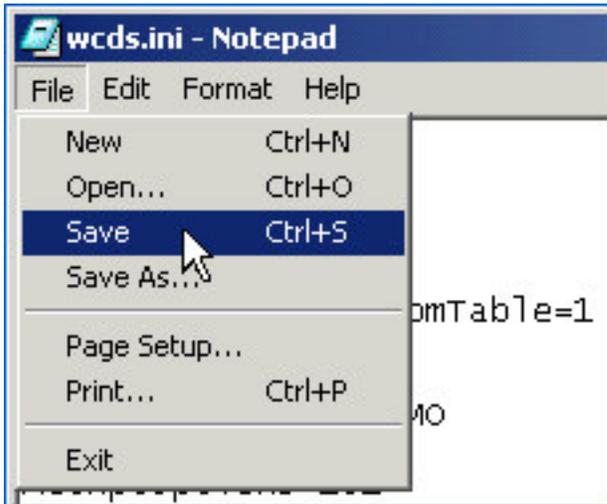
- The wcds.ini file will open in a **Notepad** window.
- Look for the heading **System** in brackets.

wcds.ini - Notepad

- Find the last entry under the System heading (before the next heading in brackets).
- Left-click at the end of the entry to create a new entry.
  - To launch the CDS Calendar in DayView at Login, type Startup=Dayview.
  - To the launch the CDS Calendar in WeekView at Login, type Startup=Weekview.
  - To the launch the CDS Calendar in MonthView at Login, type Startup=Monthview.

- After typing the new entry, select **File** from the main menu then select **Save**.



- Close the wcds.ini **Notepad** window.

When you open CDS, the Calendar will automatically open to the view specified in the wcds.ini file.
